h) A witness who is in custody <u>for not giving bail</u> shall be at once released upon giving bail required.

 An appeal may not be dismissed because the defendant <u>did not</u> <u>give</u> notice of appeal in open court. j) The court shall order the acquitted person discharged and immediately released if the evidence <u>does not establish</u> that disposition under Subsection (c), (d), or (e) is appropriate.

k) A juror who is properly summoned and <u>does not appear</u>, other than a juror exempted by law, commits an offense.

 A defendant committed <u>for not giving</u> bond shall be discharged by the officer having him in custody, upon giving the required bond, or at the expiration of the time for which he has been committed.

 m) A law enforcement agency or an employee of a law enforcement agency is not liable for damages arising from complying or <u>not complying</u> with Subsection (b) of this article.
